Marine Operations *for Marine Energy Projects*

This course is part of a series of short courses developed by the Aqua-RET (Aquatic Renewable Energy Technologies) consortium. Aqua-RET is an EU-funded Leonardo da Vinci project and is currently in its second phase. During the first phase the project consortium successfully developed an e-learning tool (www.aquaret.com) which was supported by a series of technology posters.

The course is aimed at Technology Developers, Project Developers, Supply Chain and Utilities and to a lesser extent Regulators and new entrants.
